Now we have our third and final batch of photos to debut for you, from the segment titled "Bitch" by Simon Rumley, director of RED WHITE & BLUE and THE LIVING AND THE DEAD.

"Each segment in LITTLE DEATHS is narratively and stylistically completely different," Rumley tells Fango, "and although they deal with the same psychosexual themes, they each treat horror in a different way. 'Bitch' is really a relationship drama with a nasty ending and, like THE LIVING AND THE DEAD and RED WHITE & BLUE, is more about the horrific and disturbing ways people treat each other, and is thus more of a tragedy than an out-and-out scary movie. The film is about the sexual games that Pete [Tom Sawyer] and Claire [Kate Braithwaite] play, and occasionally, when they become a little more aggressive, he starts wearing this homemade—and creepy—mask," seen in the pic above."

LITTLE DEATHS is currently in postproduction and should be debuting next year; stay tuned for more updates. Rumley provided brief descriptions of the photos seen below:
